- Crayons-Washable

- Slipper socks/knitted socks with animals on them

- Paperback books (Harry Potter series, Nancy Drew series, The Narnia Chronicles, Soup for the Soul Series, "Heaven is for Real",
- House slippers
- Fleece pajama pants
- Sketch Books
- Socks
- Anything Alabama or Auburn
- Underwear (even the girls like the boys' boxers)
- Hair Ties (with no metal pieces)
